Behavioral Expectations for LIGHT Functions

Those who participate in LIGHT functions agree to:

- 1. Be prompt to all activities.
- Speak carefully, honoring the name and character of God by avoiding inappropriate language including substitute words (euphemisms) like darn, dang, geez, and others (for example: geez is a substitute for Jesus.)
- 3. Practice good sportsmanship and refrain from mocking, teasing, jeering, and booing.
- Dress modestly, avoiding excessively tight or short clothing, tops which reveal cleavage or midriff and baggy/saggy pants which reveal underwear.
- 5. Refrain from displays of affection between guys and girls (hand-holding, arm around the shoulder, kissing, etc.).
- 6. Refrain from bringing walkmans, boomboxes, or instruments to LIGHT functions except music classes © Conservative instrumental music will be provided by the LIGHT Board for any event where music is required (for example, roller-skating).
- 7. Remain with your children at all events and be responsible for their safety. (You may make private arrangements for a friend to be responsible for your child if you cannot attend an event.)
- 8. Remove your child from an activity if they are disturbing others.
- 9. Respect corrections from any adult leader present regarding your child's behavior (see Order of Protocol).
- 10. Bring any concerns to the leader of the activity. (If not resolved, contact the group coordinator.)

LIGHT reserves the right to deny, revoke or rescind membership at any time.

LIGHT Order of Protocol

Regarding Behavior at any LIGHT Function

- 1. If you see a child doing something wrong and their parent isn't nearby, please get involved and appropriately intervene. Then:
- Allow the parent to know what her child did and how/why you intervened. This is an important part of keeping a parent informed even if the situation was resolved.
- If the parent is unresponsive or offended by your information or suggestions, or allows the same addressed behavior to reoccur, then please contact the leader of the event where the offense occurred.
- If a problem is still unresolved after the above steps are taken, please contact the LIGHT coordinator.

Field Trips, Activities, and Classes

- 1. Only LIGHT members may attend. Any exceptions need advance approval from the LIGHT coordinator.
- 2. We encourage members to organize field trips, activities and classes. Please call the LIGHT Coordinator before making plans. This helps streamline the organizational process, checks dates and keeps the coordinator well informed. Please organize all events consistent with the list of "Behavioral Expectations for LIGHT functions"
- 3. LIGHT Activities and Classes are NOT drop-off events. The supervision and safety of children is solely the responsibility of their parent(s). By signing the membership application, you agree to hold harmless LIGHT for any injuries that may occur at any events in which you or your children participate.

Use of Area Churches/Facilities

- 1. Please be courteous to the staff.
- 2. Do not congregate in the halls near the offices as business may be disrupted.
- 3. Always strive to leave the church/facility in better condition that you found it.

Moms' Breakfast (8:00-10:00 a.m.)

- 1. The Moms' Breakfast is the only LIGHT function that non-members may attend.
- 2. No children please—except nursing babies.
